

Era Fashion Committee Update

There are going to be three vacancies on the Era Fashion Committee for the two year term that begins on July 1, 2012. If you have ever thought about being on the Committee, now is your chance. We encourage you to apply now.

The criteria to become a member of the EFC includes:

- Active membership in the Model A Ford Club of America
- Eighteen years of age or more
- Experience with local, regional or national MAFCA activities
- Experience as a MAFCA fashion judge or entrant is desirable

Being a member of the Committee is a lot of fun and a real learning experience. We are always discovering new fashion information about the era and share this information with the Model A community. There are usually two meetings a year, one in the fall when the committee addresses the problems or successes of the current/past year's sanctioned judging events, and one meeting in the spring to review the upcoming meets for the current year. The Committee reviews all comments and inquiries received by MAFCA concerning era fashions. In addition, we make regular contributions to *The Restorer* and to the Fashion pages of the MAFCA website. The Committee reviews all fashion articles, before they are published on the MAFCA website or in *The Restorer*. We are responsible for updating the Fashion Judging Procedures Manual, the Era Fashion Judging Tests, and the *MAFCA Fashion Guidelines*.

The Committee is responsible for the MAFCA fashion judges list, working to keep information current and to keep MAFCA fashion judges informed about new information in the era fashion world. We take the lead for MAFCA in providing information to encourage members to become fashion judges.
