

Area 1 – Engine Compartment

INCLUDES: engine, fuel system (carburetor and fuel pump and lines), underside of hood, cowl and radiator lacings, engine pans, engine supports (mounts), and correct finishes.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: cooling system (inlet/outlet castings and gaskets, pump, fan, hoses, clamps, radiator), electrical system (generator, starter distributor, coil, terminal box, spark plugs, all wiring and connectors), exhaust system (manifold, gasket, exhaust pipe), steering column, nor any accessories (i.e. heaters).

TOTAL POINTS 40

GENERAL

Finish, workmanship, plating, materials and correctness should be foremost in judging. If any area of the engine compartment has, grease, oil, dirt, or water spots, take half of the points off that is allotted for that area. For authenticity of the various components judged in this area, refer to the current Model A Restoration Guidelines and Judging Standards. A good reproduction part shall receive 50% of the points for that item, but a modern part (after 1939) will receive 0 points.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: lamps (correctness, plating, or working order), horn, instruments, electric wipers, starter rod button, or accessories.



Area 3 - Cooling System

INCLUDES: radiator, shroud (if any), era hoses and clamps, water pump, fan, fan belt, water inlet, and outlet castings.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: radiator cap, radiator shell, and accessories.

GENERAL

Finish, workmanship, plating, materials and correctness should be foremost in judging. Check to make sure that the proper "like kind" fasteners, wire ties and clamps are uniform and installed correctly, and there are no leaks. For authenticity of the various components judged in this area, refer to the current Model A Restoration Guidelines and Judging Standards. A good reproduction part shall receive 50% of the points for that item, but a modern part (after 1939) will receive 0 points.

Area 4 - Undercarriage

INCLUDES: frame and cross members, axles, springs, radius rods, steering linkage, battery box, transmission, torque tube, running board and fender brackets, bumper arms and cross braces, flywheel housing, proper grease fittings, and underside of the body for correctness, finishes, , etc.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: wheels, brake drums, backing plates, brake rods, brake cross shafts, spring hangers (shackles), shocks, exhaust system, running boards, or bumpers.

Make sure cotter pins are neatly installed where required, and loose fitting in linkages. Finish, workmanship, plating, materials and correctness should be foremost in judging. For authenticity of the various components judged in this area, refer to the current Model A Restoration Guidelines and Judging Standards. A good reproduction part shall receive 50% of the points for that item, but a modern part (after 1939) will receive 0 points.

Area 5 - Exhaust System

INCLUDES: exhaust manifold, gaskets, muffler with integral inlet and tail pipes, muffler inlet clamp, and muffler tail pipe bracket. Headers and 2 or 3 piece exhaust systems are allowed.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: any other parts of the engine.

TOTAL POINTS: 10

DOES NOT INCLUDE: steering column controls, wiper, accessory gauges, gas shutoff valve, window or door hardware, or top hardware of open cars.

Accessory gauges are allowed for oil pressure, and water temperature. A good reproduction item shall receive 50% of the points, but a modern item like a tach gauge will receive 0 points.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: side curtains and painted visors.







Area 13 - Sheet Metal

INCLUDES: all exterior, painted metal panels, including hood, visor, doors, body sections, fenders, running boards, splash shields, etc. and the welting, fasteners, markings, finishes, and workmanship on the panels.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: plated parts, firewall, underside of hood, underside of body, paint or striping, inside cargo area or bed (including equipment mounted thereon) of commercial vehicles.

TOTAL POINTS: 50

GENERAL

Correctness, quality, and workmanship should be foremost in judging this area. Dents, metal workmanship are judged here. Do not judge condition of paint here. Speedsters will receive full points for fenders, aprons, running boards, and doors if they do not have them. For authenticity of the various components judged here, refer to the current Model A Restoration Guidelines and Judging Standards. A good reproduction part shall receive 50% of the points for that item, but a modern part (after 1939) and fiberglass parts will receive 0 points.

INCLUDES: exterior paint on body, fenders, hood, aprons, visor, any other exterior parts such as running boards, radiator shell, finish on wood and metal hardware, wagons, commercial or other wooden bodies, and striping.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: wheels, undercarriage, firewall, or underside of body, on all vehicles, and bed or cargo area on commercial vehicles.


GENERAL

Correctness, quality, and workmanship should be foremost in judging this area. Any Model A color from 1928-1931 is acceptable. If a non stock color is used, a variance must be required (i.e. a speedster is painted for sponsorship). Metallic paint will be given 0 points. Fendered cars must have black fenders. Speedsters will receive full points for fenders, aprons, and running boards if they do not have them. For authenticity of the various components judged here, refer to the current Model A Restoration Guidelines and Judging Standards. A good reproduction part shall receive 50% of the points for that item, but a modern part (after 1939) will receive 0 points.

Area 15 - Exterior Plating

INCLUDES: correctness, condition, plating and finish of all bright work <u>outside</u> the vehicle. Those items include bumpers, luggage racks, radiator shell (also painted commercial shells), door and deck handles, windshield frames (when appropriate), gas and radiator caps, cowl bands and lights, rumble step plates, top rests, lamp and horn conduits, and plating on head lights.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: correctness or plating of landau irons, rear curtain light frame, mirror brackets and glass, interior bright work, running board trim, accessories, wipers, hubcaps and tire valve hardware.

Area 16 - Accessories

DOES NOT INCLUDE: normal variations of production models (such as fender step plates, welled fender(s), or safety items.

The tail pipe should not show evidence of oil burning or running too rich. There should be no wobbly pulleys, water or oil leaks. The engine should not knock at any time, and the AMP gauge should show a positive charge rate.
