

Marshall & Veta Lewis Award

1. Purpose. The Award will be presented at a MAFCA National Convention, for the outstanding couple's fashion in the Original, Reproduction and Era Image categories. The Award honors Marshall and Veta Lewis who participated in couples fashion judging at many National Conventions.
2. Requirements. The winning couples must be MAFCA members and have the highest overall fashion score in the Original, Reproduction and Era Image categories.
3. Selection. The following are judging criteria that should be followed for this award:
 - A. Only one award shall be given to the highest overall couple in each of the three categories: Original, Reproduction and Era Image.
 - B. Entrants must be entered in the fashion judging competition as an Adult Couple.
 - C. Entrants must complement each other in attire; e.g., both dressed in daytime, sports attire, etc.
 - D. Each entrant must have scored First Place or better in points to qualify for the awards.
 - E. Each couple will be judged individually, and the combined average of the two scores will be used to determine the highest score.
 - F. In the case of a tie in points, the tie will be broken by a decision of the judging team.
 - G. A couple is eligible for this award more than once, but the winning attire (both individuals Major Garment) must be different from what was worn for the previous award.
4. Award and Presentation. The Marshall & Veta Lewis Award will be provided by MAFCA. The engraving shall include the phrase "Marshall & Veta Lewis Award, Original, Reproduction and Era Image Category and Model A Ford Club of America". Presentation to the winning couples will be made by Marshall Lewis, if present, or by the Chief Fashion Judge at the fashion award presentations. This award can only be presented at MAFCA National Conventions.
