

Fashion Awards

1. Purpose. The purpose of this section is to define the classes of fashions and establish requirements for the awarding of the “Best of Each Fashion Category Award” to entrants of era fashion judging competition at MAFCA National Conventions and other MAFCA Sanctioned Fashion Events. The purpose of the “Best of Each Fashion Category Award” is to honor the outstanding individual entry in Original, Reproduction and Model A ERA Image categories.

Note: This section replaces Addenda to Part III, Section 7, Era Fashion Committee.

2. Fashion Classifications: The following three classes or categories of era fashions are recognized for judging competition and awards:
 - A. Original - fashions manufactured or made, by machine or hand, for wear during 1928 through 1931.
 - B. Reproduction - fashions manufactured or made after 1931, by machine or hand, to represent as closely as possible that which was original.
 - C. Model A Era Image – Achieve look of Model A era.

Additional groupings of fashions within these two categories are defined in the *MAFCA Fashion Guidelines*.

3. Awards:

4. General Requirements: In order to be eligible for these awards, entrants must meet the following requirements:
- A. Must be registered for the meet.
 - B. Fashion judges for a meet are not permitted to enter fashion judging competition at that meet, but are encouraged to wear a Model A era fashion while judging.
5. Trophies. All trophies and awards are to be funded by the general meet funds. MAFCA will provide the Award of Excellence lapel pin and the Lewis Award (Highest Scoring Couple in Original and Reproduction) at National Conventions only.
