

Jack Payton Memorial Award

1. Purpose. The purpose of the Jack Payton Memorial Award is to honor the spirit of participation so important to the success of the Model A Ford Club of America, and shall be awarded to the individual judged to be the most outstanding participant at the National Convention. This award shall be given in the memory of a great Model A enthusiast, and one of MAFCA's founders, Jack Payton.
2. Requirements. Candidates for the Jack Payton Memorial Award shall actively participate in the MAFCA National Convention activities with his or her own Model A Ford as follows:
 - A. Participate in gymkhana
 - B. Enter fashion judging
 - C. Enter car judging

The points achieved in these events shall be used as necessary to determine the award recipient in accordance with the procedure as outlined in the policy on the MAFCA Participation Award (see Part II, Section 5, Subsection H).

3. Presentation. The Jack Payton Memorial Award shall be presented at the National Convention Awards Banquet.
4. Award. A trophy award, supplied by MAFCA, shall be presented as the Jack Payton Memorial Award. The winner's name shall also be added to the plaque at national headquarters detailing the Payton award.
5. Judging. The judging for the Jack Payton Memorial Award shall be conducted by a three-member group. Two members shall be provided by the national meet host group and one member shall be appointed by the MAFCA President.
