

Model A Youth Driving Award

1. Purpose. The purpose of the Model A Youth Driving Award is to encourage interest and participation in the Model A hobby among the youth of our organization. This shall be done by the administration of a two-part examination consisting of a written portion and a driving test.
2. Requirements. Candidates for the Model A Driving Award must be between the ages of 15 through 19. A valid driver's license in the participant's home state or country is a necessity. The candidate must be a registered convention participant or a relative or guest of a registered convention participant.
3. Selection Criteria. A driving test shall be set up and staffed by the host chapter or appropriately designated personnel. This test should take into consideration good safety practices and include, but not be limited to, testing on starting, stopping, maneuvering, gear shifting, and any other items pertaining to the safe and skillful driving of the Model A Ford. Participation in the gymkhana may also be included.

A written examination based partially on the Model A Ford owner's manual will be given. The examination will consist of clear and concise questions relating to the operation, maintenance and general knowledge of the Model A Ford.

4. Judging. Scores from both the driving and written examinations shall be averaged to determine the recipient of the award. The staff involved shall be in charge of determining the winner.
5. The Model A Youth Driving Award shall be presented at the MAFCA National Convention Awards Banquet.
6. Award. A perpetual award shall be engraved with the recipient's name and placed on display at headquarters. The recipient shall receive a trophy or plaque to be retained in his personal possession.
