

## GENERAL

Finish, workmanship, plating, materials and correctness should be foremost in judging. For authenticity of the various components judged here, refer to the current Model A Restoration Guidelines and Judging Standards. A good reproduction part shall receive 50\% of the points for that item, but a modern part (after 1939) will receive 0 points.

## ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

Starter and switch (any pre 1939, fuse box is allowed)

Generator, cutout or alternator

Distributor (Model A or B, after market to 1939, $50 \%$ reduction in points for after 1939)

Battery \& Cables
Spark plugs

## Coil

Ignition cable (Original or braided) - 50\% reduction in points for plastic coated

Wiring, electrical connectors, terminal box
(Wiring must be braided, 50\% reduction in points for plastic coated)
