June 25, 2010 - Day Nine, Day Two of the Return Home. We left Evanston at 7:30 AM, until we got to Salt Lake, it was a cool ride. Blake wrapped up in a blanket, and looked like a cocoon. We saw a horrible car wreck in Park City Utah, a small SUV completely engulfed in flames. The drive through Salt Lake was exciting, the interchanges there are awful. I was watching the Garmin when I should have been watching the road. Got lost, but the Garmin did get us back on track quite well. Once on I-80 West, we didn't have any further problems. The drive across the Salt Flats was good, we had a tail wind, so it made an easy drive. After we stopped in West Windover for lunch, we picked up the wind, and the heat. Drove another 110 miles to Elko, and that is where we are spending the night. At this point, we are traveling with Dave and Trudy Vestal, and will be until tomorrow afternoon, then we split, and we go South on 395. We did pick up another Model A coming through West Windover, but they didn't stop in Elko when we did.



The Salt Flats are well named, they are flat, and quite White
