June 24, 2010 - Day Eight, Day One of the Return Home. We left Casper at 7:00 AM, the mileage on 'Hank' was 91711, which means we drove 1516 Model A miles since we left home, or 1682 miles in anything else. We took a different way home than we came, going to Rawlings first, then onto I-80 to Evanston. Along the way, we saw antelope everywhere, I was reminded on the Home on The Range song, "where the deer and the buffalo play", except in this case, it antelope and deer. We ate breakfast in Rawlins, then drive to Evanston, where we stayed 4 nights ago on the way to Casper.
